

Privacy Policy

This privacy statement covers the website <http://www.minds-et-motion.com/> . By using our website you agree to the collection and use of information by Minds et Motion Ltd as described below.

The Data Controller for this website is Minds et Motion Ltd, which also manages the website.

The purpose of this privacy statement is to inform users of the website about:

- What information is collected about them when they visit this site
- How this information is used
- Whether this information is disclosed and in what circumstances
- The ways in which we protect users' privacy.

Information confidentiality and security

Your email address and any other details about you **will not be** disclosed or passed on to third parties, unless you grant us your permission, or in exceptional circumstances in which such disclosure is required by a lawful government request or to comply with the demands of the law or to protect the security of the website and/or other users of the website against a specific threat or issue.

Information we collect from visitors

We collect several kinds of information from our users and about how they use our website. The data is **never passed to third parties**. Any data we collect is used by Minds et Motion Ltd for the following reasons:

- To ensure that we are offering our community the best service that we can, and where relevant at competitive prices.
- We may email you occasionally with requests for feedback about the site or your account, with queries about your posts, or with information for example, changes to our privacy policy or terms and conditions.

We collect information from you:

- When you create a profile on the website we will collect your email address and other personal data as supplied by you.

- When you use the website.
- Through cookies.
- If you choose to reveal information in forum posts, comments and reviews.
- When you enter competitions.
- When you sign up to our mailing list.

We may process data about your use of our website and services for our analytics tracking. We use Google Analytics and you can read about their privacy policy [here](#). The data we collect may include your IP address, geographical location, referral source, length of visit, page views and website navigation paths, as well as information regarding which pages are accessed and when.

When you register you will have the option to subscribe to our mailing list. You will only be added to that list if you subscribe. At any time you can decide not to receive these emails and will be able to 'unsubscribe'.

Who we share data with

We will not sell your data to any third party. We **will not share** your personal information with others for marketing purposes unless you have given us your

permission. If we have your permission, we will share your information only with other organisations we have chosen carefully.

Our website contains links to other websites which are not covered by this privacy policy. We use plug-ins from other organisations such as Twitter, Facebook and Pinterest. If you access other sites using the links provided, or share our content via these social media platforms, the operator of those sites may collect information from you which will be used in accordance with their own privacy policy. Links to other sites do not signify that we endorse them nor do we have any responsibility for the content of the linked website.

Use of Cookies

Site usage data in the form of log files and tracking cookies. Log files are maintained to help us keep the website secure. Cookies are used to make access to the website simpler and quicker for returning visitors (e.g. allowing forms to be pre-loaded), and visitors are able to turn off cookies in their browsers without affecting their ability to access the site and all its functionality. In addition, cookies are used to help create site usage statistics, e.g. which pages are the most read and which pages are the least read. Neither the log files nor cookies contain any personal information about you and cannot be used to identify an individual user. By using the site you are agreeing to the use of cookies as described.

Transferring data outside the European Economic Area (EEA)
